This month's speaker during dinner will be Alex Cosby, who will be giving a presentation called, "Masonic Symbols and Jungi-

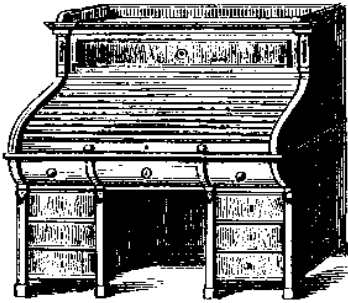
an Psychology." I look forward to seeing you all at our October 1st dinner and stated meeting.

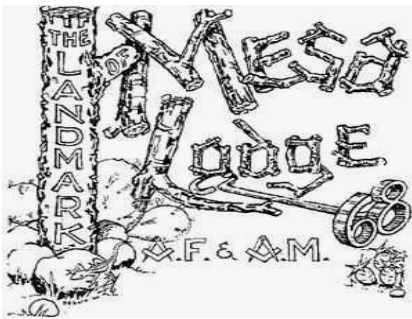
