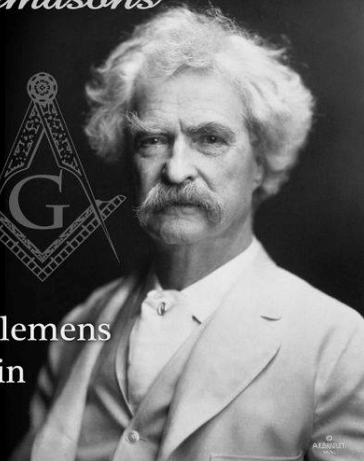

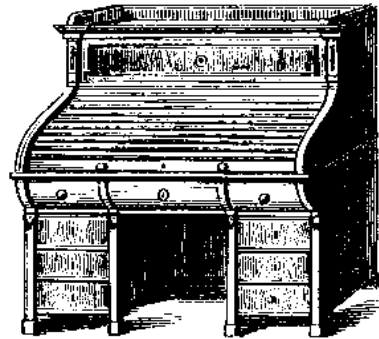
The summer session is underway at the SRLDC. Students attend Monday through Thursday and have a full session. The first student arrives at 9 a.m. and the last one at 2 p.m.

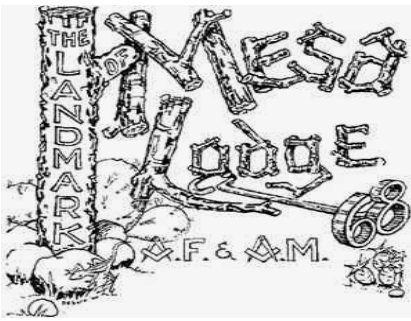
